

1. GENERAL INFORMATION.

1. The operator of the website/shop zwolinska.shoplo.com is Leszek Smolik, 62m25 Wilcza Street.

2. The service performs the functions of obtaining information about users and their behavior in the following way:

- Through information voluntarily entered in the forms.
 - By storing cookies on the terminal equipment (so-called "cookies").
 - By collecting web server logs by the hosting operator.
- operating at www.shoplo.com.

2. INFORMATION IN THE FORMS

1. Service collects information provided voluntarily by the user.

2. The service may also save information about the parameters of the connection (time stamp, address IP)

3. The data in the form shall not be made available to third parties other than with the consent of the user.

4. The data given in the form may constitute a set of potential customers, registered by the Operator of the Website in the register kept by the General Security Inspector Personal data.

5. The data provided in the form are processed for the purpose resulting from the function of the specific form, e.g. for the service request process or contact commercial.

6. The data given in the forms may be provided to the technical entities implementing certain services - in particular the provision of information on the holder of a registered domain to entities that are operators of Internet domains (primarily all Scientific and Academic Computer Network j.b.r.- NASK), services handling payments or other entities with whom the Operator of the Website, including to the extent of cooperation.

3. INFORMATION ABOUT COOKIES

1. The website uses cookies.

2. Cookie files (so-called "cookies") are IT data, in particular the files text, which are stored in the Service User's end device and are intended to use the websites of the Service. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they come, the duration of their storage on the end device and a unique number. Entity placing on the terminal equipment of the Service User cookies and the operator of the Service is the one who gets access to them.

4. Cookies are used for the following purposes:

- creating statistics that help to understand how Service Users use the websites to improve their structure and the contents
- maintaining the Service User session (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter the login and password on each subpage of the Service
- define a user profile in order to display matched materials in advertising networks, in particular Google networks.

5. Two basic types of cookies are used in the Service: "session" cookies (session cookies) and 'permanent' cookies (persistent cookies). "Session" cookies are temporary files, which are stored in the user's end device until logging out, leave the website or turn off the software (browser (Internet)). "Permanent" cookies are stored in the terminal device of User for the time specified in the parameters of cookie files or until their removal by the User.

6. Software for web browsing (web browser) usually, by default, allows cookies to be stored on the terminal device User. Service users may change their settings in this area.

The Internet browser allows you to delete cookies. It is also possible automatic blocking of cookies For details, see help or documentation for your web browser.

7. Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some features available on the website of the Service.

8. Cookies placed in the final device of the Service User and may also be used by those cooperating with the operator of the Service advertisers and partners.

10. Cookies may be used by advertising networks, in particular Google, to display ads that match the way you use the Service. For this purpose, they may retain information about your navigation path or time to stay on the site.

4. SERVER LOGS

1. Information about certain user behavior is logged in the layer of the server room. This data is used solely for the purpose of administering the service and in order to ensure the most efficient service of the hosting services provided.

2. The resources viewed are identified by their URLs. In addition, records may be subject:

- time of inquiry,
- time to send the answer,
- client station name - identification implemented by the HTTP protocol,
- information on errors that occurred during the execution of HTTP transactions,
- URL of the page previously visited by the user (referrer link) - in if the transition to the Service was made through a link,
- information about your browser,
- Information about the IP address.

3. The above data is not associated with any particular person visiting the website.

4. The above data is used only for the purpose of administration of the server.

5. PROVIDING DATA

1. The data are made available to external entities only within the legal limits allowed.

2. Data enabling the identification of a natural person shall be provided only with the consent of that of a person.

3. The Operator may be obliged to provide information collected by the Service to authorized bodies on the basis of lawful requests to the extent that from the request.

6. COOKIE MANAGEMENT - HOW TO DO IT IN PRACTICE GIVE AND TAKE BACK CONSENT?
